REGULAR MEETING

JULY 13, 2026

CALL TO ORDER

The July 13, 2026 regular meeting of the Corydon Township Supervisors was called to order at 6:00 pm by Dennis Faucher, Supervisor Chairman. The Pledge of Allegiance Followed.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

- Audits – PMRS and Liquid Fuels audits were discussed, and paperwork presented for submission.

- Cornplanter Cemetery Road Repair – Dennis Faucher will contact the Seneca Nation regarding this repair.
- McKean County Maintenance Culvert Project – Doug Cobb was present to discuss. According to PennDOT, this can be done in two weeks. There will be no temporary bridge bypass. Many concerns have been voiced, and it was decided to email the engineers to request another meeting to discuss the Township's concerns: Emergency services, the effect to local businesses, to name a few.
