

# CORYDON TOWNSHIP SUPERVISORS

## REGULAR MEETING

October 15, 2024

### CALL TO ORDER

The October 15, 2024 regular meeting of the Corydon Township Supervisors was called to order at 6:00 pm by Dennis Faucher, Chairman. The Pledge of Allegiance Followed.

### PRESENT

Dennis Faucher, Raymond Douglass, Michael Yohe, Supervisors; Lisa Godding, Secretary/Treasurer; Stan Pecora Solicitor; Public: Brenden Fox.

### APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Raymond Douglass made the motion to adopt the September 9, 2024 minutes. Michael Yohe seconded; all were in favor.

### NEW BUSINESS

- DCED Local Share Grant – Plow Truck Purchase – Resolution – The Authorized Official Resolution for the grant was presented. This is required for the application process.
- Act 205 – Volunteer Fire Relief Allocation – The payment remittance for this was presented: \$1631.60. Funds were deposited into the PLGIT General account. They are to be distributed to our local fire company that serve Corydon Township.
- Bus Stop Signs – A citizen concern arose regarding placement of signs to alert drivers of bus stops. After reaching out to Bradford Area School District Director of Transportation, it was decided that no action needs to be taken, as West Washington Street has no stops where there is less than 500 feet sight distance to a bus stop.
- Plowing and Sanding – Lafayette Township – Rates will remain the same as last year: \$75 per trip for plowing and \$125 per trip for plowing and sanding. This applies to Klondike Road
- Liquid Fuels Reimbursement – The acknowledgement of \$4,892.12 being transferred from the PLGIT General Fund to the PLGIT State Fund was presented.
- Liquid Fuels Estimated Allocation – 2025 – The Notice of Estimated Allocation Municipal Liquid Fuels and Turnback was presented: \$26,985.64.
- Liquor Control Board – License renewal payment remittance: \$150.00
- Commonwealth of PA DOT Winter Maintenance Agreement Reimbursement - \$48,638.24. The Payment Remittance was presented. Funds to be deposited into the PLGIT General Fund.
- McKean County Board of Elections – The Presidential Election announcement of delivery of voting equipment.
- McKean County Assessment Office – Authorization of Ownership/Address Change – The notification was presented for signature.
- ARPA Grant – Application for Reimbursement - Infrastructure/Blight Remediation receipts were presented. The application signed by Supervisors. Funds to be deposited to the General Fund for reimbursement.
- PSATS UC Group Trust – The rate of the Trust remains at 0.90% - rate remains the same for all categories.
- Complaint Referral – PA Department of Environmental Protection – An email was received from the DEP stating their “office has received complaints regarding large piles of garbage as well as excessive amounts of smoke and odors from open burning” occurring at a Corydon Township residence. The Corydon Township Office is to investigate.

- Bradford Forest LLC – Road Bond – Presented to the Supervisors.
- Allegheny National Forest – Road Agreements – more information will be forthcoming.
- Budget – 2025 – A Budget Workshop is scheduled for November 12<sup>th</sup> after the Regular Meeting.

#### **OLD BUSINESS**

- Verizon Internet – The Supervisors agreed to cancel the Verizon Internet service.

#### **ROAD DEPARTMENT REPORT**

Dennis Faucher presented the September 2024 Road Report:

- Patched holes on Old State Road
- Mowed Old State Road and Klondike Road
- Patched holes on Wolf Run Road
- Took the Mack for PA state inspection
- Removed downed tree on Klondike Road
- Called for the Township septic system to be pumped

#### **SECRETARY/TREASURER REPORT**

- Balance Sheet as of September, 2024 was presented.

#### **APPROVAL TO PAY EXPENSES**

A motion was made by Raymond Douglass to pay expenses, and a second by Michael Yohe. All were in favor.

Concerns were addressed during the New Business.
